

How to care for your Mossed Ivy Bear:



1. Water once the soil in the pot of your Mossed Ivy Bear Topiary is dry to the touch under the surface; check regularly, especially if kept in a hot, dry spot.
2. When watering, remove your Topiary in its plastic pot from the Red Tin container and use about 1 cup of water poured directly on the soil. In order not to damage your furniture, countertop or floor, place your Mossed Ivy Bear Topiary in a saucer, bowl or sink when watering. Allow the water to drain for 5 minutes and then replace your Topiary back into the Red Tin container. Do not allow the soil to sit in water for any more than 5 minutes or damage to the roots will occur.
3. Sprinkling the vines and leaves with water a little in between watering is also beneficial to keeping your plant looking good and preventing insect pests.
4. Fertilize lightly with a complete fertilizer once a month if your plant is actively growing.
5. Trim off unwanted or excessive growth or pin vines to the body to cover undesired open areas.
